**PROMOTION FOR THE 7<sup>TH</sup> ACGTDT  
GOES FULL BLAST**

The Philippine Consulate General in New York wishes to invite the public to participate in the 7<sup>th</sup> **Ambassadors, Consuls General and Tourism Directors Tour of the Philippines (ACGTDT)** to be held from **11 to 14 July 2012**. The ACGTDT is a joint project of the Philippine Department of Tourism (DOT) and the Philippine Embassies and Philippine Consulates General in the US and Canada.

To accommodate more participants, travelers now have the option of taking a **3-night or 4 night Basic Tour package**, which includes international round-trip ticket (departing New York on 9 or 10 July), three- or four-night-stay at Dusit Thani Hotel in Makati City with daily buffet breakfast and two lunches, dinners with cultural show and entertainment, historic wreath-laying ceremony at Rizal Park, visit to Malacañang Palace with lunch, meeting and photo-opportunity with President Benigno S. Aquino III, religious tour (Visita Iglesia), immersion program, special tour, and out-of-town tour to Las Casas de Acuzar in Bataan with lunch and fiesta activities.

The 3-night package costs **\$2,190/pax** while the 4-night package is **\$2,740/pax**.

After the Basic Tour, travelers can take any of the **optional Post Tours packages** for additional fees. Destinations include Laoag-Vigan, Legazpi, Puerto Princesa, Cebu-Bohol, Iloilo-Bacolod, Kalibo-Boracay and Davao. Dive certification and golf tour packages are also part of the Optional Tours.

The 7<sup>th</sup> ACGTDT coincides with the launching of the DOT's new campaign slogan "It's More Fun in the Philippines" so it promises to be more exciting.
