NEW YORK, 4 September 2018 – The Philippine Consulate General in New York delivered consular services to the Filipinos and Filipino-Americans at the Ramada Hotel in Saco, Maine during the Labor Day Consular Outreach on 1 September 2018.

Almost 200 services were provided to the community: 75 Passport applications, 18 Dual Citizenship, 11 Notarials and Authentication, 15 Civil Registry, and 70 Overseas Voting Registration. Applicants were grateful to the team, led by Consul Khrystina Corpuz Popov, for having them avail of the consular services without missing work and traveling to New York.
