APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION: PHILIPPINE RECORDING OF NAMES

Under Philippine Law, the recording of names for official records are as follows:

1. Based on the information given at the time of birth, as recorded in the Birth Certificate authenticated by the National Statistics Office or the Philippine Statistics Authority
 - The child can have any number of "Given Name/s"
 - The "Middle Name" shall follow the unmarried Surname of the mother
 - The "Last Name" shall follow the Surname of the father
2. For Married Women, the union of two families is honored
 - The "Given Name" remains as recorded in the Birth Certificate
 - If using the Surname of the husband, the maiden "Last Name" shall become the new "Middle Name"
 - If using a hyphen to join the maiden "Last Name" with the husband's Surname, the "Middle Name" shall remain the Surname of the mother
 - To Amend a Passport to reflect the Married Name of an applicant, she must present a Marriage Certificate issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority (formerly NSO) or a Report of Marriage issued by the Philippine Foreign Service Post.

Supporting Documents: Present original and photocopy of passport data page and Green Card / ID.
